MORE THAN 1/3 OF FALLS ARE PREVENTABLE

In 2017-2018, for children aged 1–4 and 5– 14, falls were the leading cause of injury-related ED visits.



CAREGIVERS ARE PRESENT 82.9% OF THE TIME DURING A PEDIATRIC FALL

87% occur in bedroom

13% occur in bathroom



BED SIZE PLAYS A FACTOR IN FALL RISK

87% occur in adult beds
